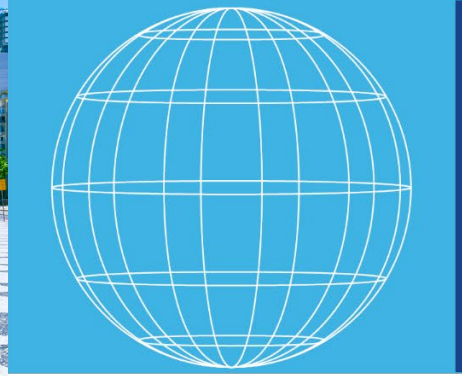

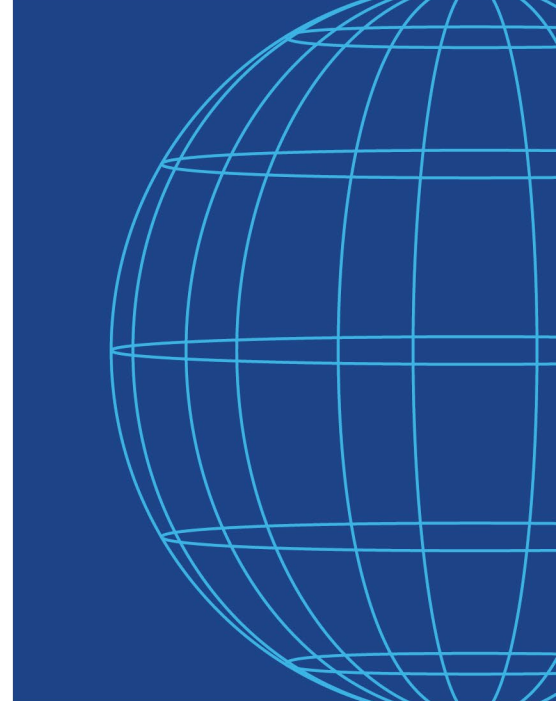

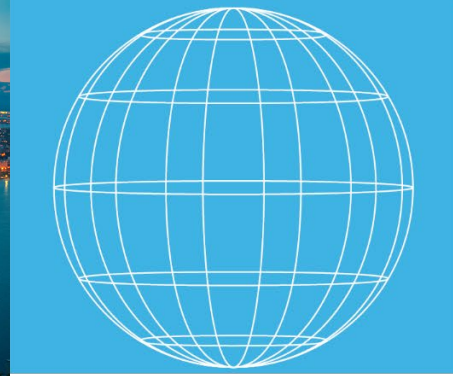
## Transport from Airport – City
