Overview

Giro Maccheroni advises management clients on labor and employment law matters. Earlier in his legal career, Giro served as a judicial intern to the Hon. Joseph F. Bianco of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit. He drafted memoranda and observed appellate proceedings. He also gained experience in trusts and estates matters as a legal intern in the office of a New York attorney, drafting estate planning documents and assisting with trust administration and asset protection.
