Overview

Throughout her time at the FBI, Kelly litigated both complex and single plaintiff cases before the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and the Merit Systems Protection Board. She conducted training sessions and served as a subject matter expert on federal discrimination, whistleblowing, and wage and hour laws. She also worked with the Department of Justice on federal district court and appellate litigation and served as a Special Assistant United States Attorney in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania.

Prior to federal service, Kelly worked at two global law firms where she represented clients in numerous complex litigation matters, including discrimination class actions and wage and hour collective actions.
